

## Directions to the Planet M

### By tram: Coming from the main station

First, take the tram (called "Üstra") number 3, 7, 9 towards "Wettbergen, Empelde" from the main station.

Change at "Kröpcke" and take the tram number 6 or 16 towards "Messe Ost". Leave the train at its final destination ("Messe Ost").

Exiting the train go straight – cross the pedestrian bridge – cross the open square in front of you to approach the round, silver building standing on metal struts (it looks like an Alien UFO ;-)) – turn left in front of the silver building to reach a brown building (connected to the "UFO" by a bridge) – enter through here.

### By car: Coming from the north (Hamburg)

Drive on the A7 southwards.

After the exit "Altwarmbüchen" change to the A37/B3 ("Messeschneelweg").

Take the exit toward "Laatzen/Messe Süd".

Turn right at the first traffic light onto "Lissabonner Allee".

Turn left at the second traffic light onto "Expo Plaza".

Before passing a pedestrian bridge the conference center "Planet M" is located on the right hand side in a round, silver building standing on metal struts (it looks like an Alien UFO ;-)).

To enter the conference center: Park the car – use the stairs located at the pedestrian bridge – once you arrived on the bridge turn left – the conference center is located on your right hand side – you will find the entrance in a brown building next to the conference center (connected to the "UFO" by a bridge)

### By car: Coming from the south (Munich)

Drive on the A9, A3 and A7 towards Hannover.

Change to A37/B3 ("Messeschneelweg") in the motorway intersection ("Autobahnkreuz") "Hannover-Süd".

Take the exit toward „Laatzen/H.-Bemerode/Messe“.

Turn left at the first traffic light onto "Expo Plaza".

Reaching the second traffic light you go straight ahead.

Before passing a pedestrian bridge the conference center "Planet M" is located on the right hand side in a round, silver building standing on metal struts (it looks like an Alien UFO ;-)).

To enter the conference center: Park the car – use the stairs located at the pedestrian bridge – once you arrived on the bridge turn left – the conference center is located on your right hand side – you will find the entrance in a brown building next to the conference center (connected to the "UFO" by a bridge)

**By car: Coming from the west (Dortmund)**

Drive on the A1 and A2 towards Hannover.

Change to the A37/B3 (“Messeschnellweg”) at the motorway intersection (“Autobahnkreuz”) “Hannover Buchholz” towards Hannover city center (“Hannover Zentrum”)

Take the exit toward “Laatzen/Messe Süd”.

Turn right at the first traffic light onto “Lissabonner Allee”.

Turn left at the second traffic light onto “Expo Plaza”.

Take the exit toward “Laatzen/Messe Süd”.

Turn right at the first traffic light onto “Lissabonner Allee”.
